to Linwood Park, where families have been vacationing since 1884

The Linwood Park Company was formed in 1883, by a group of Germans inspired by the Methodist Sunday School Assembly at Chautauqua, NY. Land was procured in Linwood Grove, a former picnic grove.

The first year twelve cottages were built, with the superintendent authorized to grant 99-year leases on the lots.

The summer of 1884 saw the completion of the Tabernacle, the Chapel, superintendent's house, and a horse shed. The first 4th of July celebration was held, and the summer fun began.

Now home to some year-round residents, most cottages are still summer homes. Some are available for rent by owners.



Park Rules

1. Park fees apply to all persons 11 years and older. Tickets purchased at the Park entry.
2. Speed limit is 10 M.P.H.
3. Meetings held on the grounds and selling of any item must be authorized by the Park Company.
4. Skateboards or motorized bikes are not permitted in the Park.
5. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the Park grounds.
6. Beach closes at 10:00 p.m.
7. Sunday church services are between 9:00 a.m. – noon, quiet is appreciated during these hours.
8. Quiet hours are between 11 p.m. – 9 a.m.

Enjoy the Season:

The Linwood season begins the second week of June and ends on Labor Day. The park is open to the public and entrance fees apply during the season. Visiting Linwood during the off-season may be arranged by contacting the Park Superintendent.

Enjoy the beach, play tennis or shuffle board, have fun at the playground, or just picnic in the Grove.

Lodge & Upper Rooms:

Linwood Lodge is a large facility. It accommodates 26 people, has a commercial kitchen, large dining area, comfortable living/gathering space, bathrooms on 1st and 2nd floors, and large fireplace. It is ideal for family gatherings or organizational retreats.

The Upper Rooms, located above the Stand, are perfect for cottage guest overflow or short Linwood visits. There are 8 rooms of various sizes, ranging from singles to two queen beds—each with an individual sink. There are two communal bathrooms, a refrigerator, and microwave.

The Stand features light meals, candy, ice cream, and souvenirs. FREE WiFi.

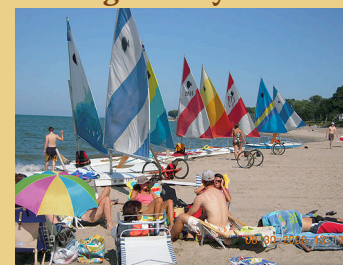
The Store is a blend of Park history exhibits and arts and crafts. Produced by Linwood community members, numerous unique art objects are available for purchase.
